GeoAutomation is a truck mounted 14, 2 MP, digital imagery camera and GPS system, providing 360°, survey-enabled, georeferenced streetscape imagery. High resolution imagery is accessed through a simple interface with all major GIS and CAD systems.

With this photogrammetrically controlled imagery, users will have survey and mapping data collection accuracy ranging from 2cm to 30cm. The technology will be of interest to Surveyors, Engineers, Mappers, and Asset Management and GIS Professionals.
